## Rules

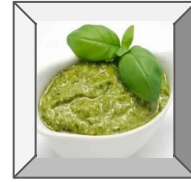
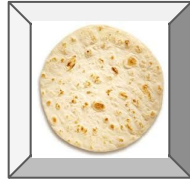
The game starts with all the cards face down on the table.

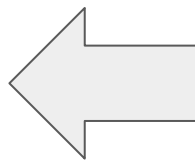

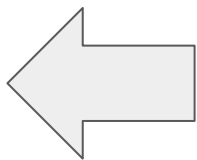

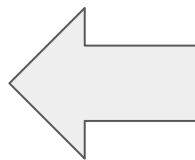
# GONDOLA

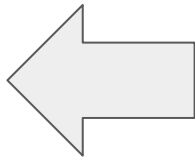
# DUOMO

Red hot peppers are berries of Capsicum plant.

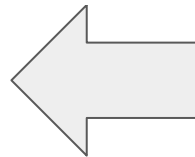

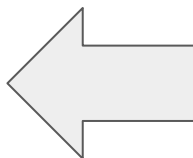
